Auxiliary Scholarship Funds:

Mary Dalton Scholarship Fund

Basic Requirements

- Enrolled or planning to attend nursing school
- Resident of Sandusky County or Memorial Hospital employee and their immediate family members. Employees living outside of Sandusky County must have five years of continuous full or part-time employment to be eligible.

Nichols Family Scholarship Fund

Basic Requirements

- Enrolled or planning to attend nursing school
- Preference will be given to those enrolled in an RN program or the LPN to RN program
- Resident of Sandusky County or Memorial Hospital employee and their immediate family members. Employees living outside of Sandusky County must have five years of continuous full or part-time employment to be eligible.

Health Education Scholarship Fund

Basic Requirements

- Enrolled or planning to study any healthcare related field.
- Resident of Sandusky County or Memorial Hospital employee and their immediate family members. Employees living outside of Sandusky County must have five years of continuous full or part-time employment to be eligible.

Foundation Scholarship Funds:

Leona M. Liskai Nursing Scholarship Fund

Basic Requirements

- Enrolled or planning to attend nursing school
- Resident of Sandusky County

Incomplete applications, those missing documentation or those submitted after the deadline will not be considered. Scholarship awards will be announced in April followed by an invitation to attend an awards reception in May.
