## **Well Visits for Preventive Health Care**

## **Greetings Paramount Providers:**

Please help our mutual members receive their required well visits. \*Infants should have a well visit at birth then 8 well visits by 15 months: within 3-5 days of birth and by 1, 2, 4, 6, 9, 12, and 15 months. Well visits are also needed by 18, 24, and 30 months of age. After 30 months of age, children and adults should have at least a yearly well visit. Thank you for your support!

PARAMOUNT ALLOWS A SICK VISIT AND A WELL VISIT ON THE SAME DAY. If this is the first time a member is seen in your office only one of the two billed visits can be billed as a new patient. For example, if a new patient is seen and both a well visit and a sick visit are appropriately received; only one service is a new patient visit and the other is an established visit. As long as the provider's documentation supports services for a well visit and a sick visit (no overlapping documentation components) then separate reimbursement is both warranted and supported. IF BILLING A "SICK VISIT" ON THE SAME DAY AS A "WELL VISIT": PLEASE BILL THE APPROPRIATE EVALUATION & MANAGEMENT CODE (I.E. 99201-99215) WITH MODIFIER – 25 AND PREVENTIVE CODE (I.E. 99381-99397).

PARAMOUNT ADVANTAGE MEDICAID MEMBERS HAVE UNLIMITED PREVENTIVE VISITS AND **DO NOT** NEED TO WAIT 365 DAYS IN ORDER TO RECEIVE A YEARLY WELL VISIT. IN ADDITION, PARAMOUNT ADVANTAGE MEDICAID MEMBERS CAN RECEIVE UNLIMITED SICK VISITS

- Consider every visit an opportunity for a preventive well visit and a vaccine visit.
- Review the date of the last preventive well visit. If it is still needed, please educate members on the
  importance of preventive care, schedule extra time to provide a well visit with a sick visit, or
  schedule an additional well visit preventive appointment.
- Schedule the next well visit or the next 2- 3 of the 8 required well visits **before** 15 months of age during check out. This helps members stay on track for their visits.
- Give an appointment reminder to members with the date and time highlighted at check out.
- Send reminder letters or call members that are due for their yearly well visit, **even when members** haven't been seen by your office. These members either chose the provider or were assigned.
- Contact members a few days prior to their appointment with **reminder messages**.
- Collaborate with your EHR vendor to incorporate **pop up alerts for** preventive services.

- Maternal Depression Screening at minimum during infant/child well visits by: 1, 2, 4, & 6 months
- Members younger than 20 years need: HT/WT and BMI % or BMI % documentation on an age growth chart. Members 20 years and older need: HT/WT & BMI Value.
