ProMedica Cancer Institute is dedicated to providing **exceptional cancer care close to home**. We uphold our commitment by continually exceeding national standards of care, improving community access to services and education, and investing in innovative technology and research.

Our patients are connected to extensive resources, including 10 cancer and infusion centers with 126 treatment areas, seven linear accelerators, one high-dose rate (HDR) radiation machine, an expert provider network, and state-of-the-art diagnostic tests, treatments and supportive therapies. Below is a snapshot of ProMedica's oncology service line performance in 2025.

INNOVATION

New Programs

- **High Risk Clinic:** launched April 2025

Improved Access

- Installed VisionRT, software for Surface Guided Radiation Therapy, improving radiation care
- Purchased new HDR equipment at ProMedica Hickman Cancer Center in Sylvania, supporting all system locations
- New radiation oncology machine at ProMedica Monroe Cancer Center
- Opened HepatoPancreaticBiliary (HPB) Clinic at ProMedica Cancer Center at Levis Commons in Perrysburg
- Expanded breast navigation services in dedicated breast surgeon's office
- Head and neck multidisciplinary cancer conference expanded to weekly cadence
